After digging through files in Archived Records, NSW Office Chester Hill, our History Sleuth, Ian R, verified that our Post Office and Telephone Exchange became known as Bonny Hills, on 1/11/1948. In 1947 the Grants Head Progress Association was formed and at a Special meeting called to rename Greenhills, it was agreed that Bonny Hills was to be the preferred option - others being Grants Head and Suterville. At the time there were only 6 permanent residents!!
